As we now serve together in ministry, we have survived and even prospered in a very difficult year, albeit with many trials. We have finished a refurbishing and upgrading at the camp property. We have added air conditioning for the heat and a light plant to provide water and refrigerator service with our frequent electrical service outages. We installed raised sidewalks to navigate the camp in the rainy season without boots or getting our shoes soaked. We painted every building on the camp to cover up the ubiquitous black mold that forms so quickly here in the tropics. As a result we have seen a very rapid increase in camp usage as nearly every weekend is booked up with one or two events. We have served more than 2,000 people in the course of this year and expect even more next year as we will start the year with the camp in excellent condition.

Another achievement is that we have continued to partner with Hasten and offer the gift of health and dental services to so many through the health and evangelism brigades that we hold nearly every weekend when we are in Colombia. We provide these services as a gift of love and with that gift we share the Good News of our Lord's gift of salvation with those who come. It has been such a blessing, and we are so thankful to Hasten for giving us the privilege of serving with them in this joyous ministry of serving the poor.

One unpleasant note and difficulty we have faced is the ongoing legal issues resulting from the embezzlement and then the shameful defamation campaign that was initiated in an attempt to cover up the illegal activity. I have had to sign off on agreeing to press charges against preachers, former friends, and even my offspring as their defamation caught the attention of state and federal prosecutors. In proving my innocence unfortunately, I had to agree to cooperate in prosecuting the guilty. If you hear of legal action involving preachers and churches you can rest assured that



it was forced upon my by the individuals who insisted in making false accusations and using defamation as a means of covering up their involvement in the embezzlement of mission funds and then refused to repent or try to repair the damage they have caused to the Lord's work in Colombia. I blame myself for failing to keep closer tabs on those handling the mission funds and certainly will be far more careful into the future.
